Managing Client Expectations and Scope Limitations

- If the client asks for additional or complicated changes, the project timeline will be adjusted to reflect the extra work. This ensures that the team isn't forced into rushing and can deliver quality work without delays.
- The team will focus on completing what was originally agreed upon within the set timeframe. Any requests outside of this will be handled separately, so they don't disrupt the current work.
